33	<b>Domaine, Frédéric - Châteauneuf-du-Pape</b> As in many properties in the region, Frédéric has good selection of varieties planted. 60% of the area is given over to Grenache, with Syrah, Mourvèdre and Cinsault each making up, roughly, 10% of the planting. The remaining 10% of surface area is planted with a selection of other permitted Châteauneuf varieties that bring complexity to the final blend, including Counoise, Vaccarèse and Terret Noir.	2013/2014	£50.00

61	<b>Gran Passione – Veneto Rosso</b> Veneto, Italy. Full in body, dark in colour, rich in berry flavours and soft in tannins, the Gran Passione is a blend of 60% Merlot and 40% Corvina. It is based on the same technique used to make Amarone. Look for some Amarone character along with ripe fruit flavours of dried cherry, raisin, prune and chocolate.	2016	£29.95

85	<b>Plot 22 - Red</b> Spain. Using the main variety from Rioja (Tempranillo) to give a good brambly flavour, add a touch of spice with the addition of some shiraz. Completely unoaked to allow the fruit to shine.		£14.75
81	<b>Hacienda Lopez de Haro Crianza - Rioja</b> Rioja, Spain. A wine of intense colour and pleasant bouquet, in which the nuances of mature fruit stand out. In the mouth it is soft, expressive and elegant, combining a fruity character with the notes lent by the cask, in perfect balance.	2015	£24.50

119	<b>Sottano - Malbec</b> Mendoza, Argentina. This Malbec exhibits scents of red and ripe fruits such as cherries and plums. The aging in French and American oak softens the palate nicely and imparts delicate chocolate and vanilla flavours too. As Malbec should be, it is full of flavour but has soft velvety tannins giving a proper long finish.	2016	£29.50

It is one of the lightest bodied red varietals yet, with ample fruit, spice, and earthiness, it easily breaks the rule that white wines must go with seafood, and red wines must go with red meats.</p>

French. The original 1945 recipe was perfected during WW2 and remains unchanged to this day. Created and distilled in Dijon, the recipe for Diplôme is one of the oldest in France.	
<b>Edinburgh Gin</b>	£3.50
Scottish. Delicately distilled with fresh juniper, coriander, citrus peel and orris root, then mix in heather and milk thistle for that piece of extra magic.	
<b>Gordon's Gin</b>	£2.50
Scottish. The distinctively refreshing taste comes from the finest handpicked juniper berries and a selection of other botanicals.	
<b>Gordon's Sloe Gin</b>	£2.50
Scottish. The first sloe berries steeped gently before adding Gordon's gin; a wonderful tippie with cassis sweetness.	
<b>Hendrick's</b>	£3.50
Scottish. Signature botanicals of flowers, roots, fruits and seeds from the world over. They function to complement and set the stage for a delicious duet of infusions: rose petal and cucumber. An extraordinarily smooth gin that has the required character and balance of subtle flavours.	
<b>Langtons Gin</b>	£4.00
English. Produced in Skiddaw, Lake District. This is a mellow gin designed for martinis or straight up, serve straight over ice or in a martini.

Scottish. First Edinburgh distilled gin, produced at Summerhall just off the meadows in the old town.	
<b>Shortcross</b>	£4.00
Northern Ireland. Created to be a classical gin with a creative twist; best described as floral meadows, wild berries and grassy notes. It is highly aromatic with an exceptionally long and smooth finish.	
<b>Strathearn Heather Rose</b>	£4.00
Scottish. From Scotland's first micro distillery comes the Strathearn Heather Rose Gin, featuring the sweet, vibrantly floral combination of classic Scottish heather and delicate rose.

### HIGHLAND SINGLE MALTS

Highland malts are defined by an imaginary line, drawn between the Firth of Clyde (Greenock) in the west and the Firth of Tay (Dundee) in the east, known as the Highland Line. North of this line is the Highlands which is the largest of the whisky producing regions in Scotland. The area has so many 'micro climates' that the flavours produced by different distillers are very different from each other and so as a result it is very hard to identify any specific characteristics of 'The Highland Malt'.

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## WHISKY

### SPEYSIDE SINGLE MALTS

Many people consider the whiskies produced in this region to be the most elegant and refined of all single malts. Most of the distilleries in Strathspey take their water from the River Spey. The area is actually in the Highlands but due to the number of distilleries and the character differences to those of the Highlands Single Malts, it has been classed as a region in its own right. The make-up of these malts range from light, soft floral whiskies to more complex and heavily sherried malts.

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## WHISKY

### THE ISLAND MALTS

The fresh sea air, on the various Islands around the perimeter of Scotland, adds a salty tang in the production of these malts. The range of whiskies from islands such as Orkney (Highland Park) and Skye (Talisker) have a hint of peatiness but unlike the malts distilled on Islay, the peat taste is softer and sweeter.

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## WHISKY

### ISLAY SINGLE MALTS

Islay is the southern most of the Inner Hebridean Islands located off the west coast of Scotland. Beaten by wind and rain and surrounded by crashing sea waves, this peat covered Island has become a Mecca for whisky lovers. The smoky, seaweedy 'peat monster' of Laphroaig is produced on the south east coast. Whiskies from this region have been described as having a medicinal flavour due to the Iodine and salty notes alongside the peat.

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## WHISKY

### THE LOWLAND MALTS

Located below the imaginary 'Highland Line', these whiskies are characterised by their delicate, light, grassy aroma's with floral notes and dry finishes. Many distilleries have closed down and if you can find malts bottled by 'Rosebank' or 'St. Magdalene' you really should give them a try although 'Glenkinchie' and 'Bladnoch' still produce excellent malts. The whiskies in this region were often triple distilled to make them lighter and more delicate but this may have led to the regions decline as single malt drinkers usually prefer heavier more complex whiskies.
